### Beth Webb Appointed to Horse Racing Advisory Committee

RWOP member, Beth Webb has been appointed by Governor Haslam to serve on the Horse Racing Advisory Committee. This seven-member committee includes five public members, a member with a background in law enforcement, and a member with a background in accountancy. Beth and the committee chair, Joe Coury of Jackson, represent West Tennessee.

Signed into law by Governor Haslam on April 28, 2016, Senate Bill 1738 allowed for the formation of the committee and directs the committee to "complete a comprehensive report and develop recommendations for legislation related to the establishment of horse racing in this state, with the ultimate goal of authorizing a state governmental entity to regulate" it. The panel is given power to "investigate, study and report on any programs, initiatives, topics or other matters" it deems appropriate and "to further the establishment of horse racing." The committee will begin meeting on May 16, 2017, and must submit its report within a year.
