

Seasoned Green Beans

4 14 oz. cans green beans, well drained

1 onion sliced on top

Mix: 1 cup dark brown sugar

½ cup apple cider vinegar

1 tsp. dried mustard

½ tsp. seasoned salt

Pour over beans and onions in 9x13 baking dish. Layer 6 applewood smoked bacon slices, cut into thirds, on top of onion. Bake at 350 for one hour, 10 minutes. Drain before serving.

Chicken Spectacular

3 cups cooked chicken

1 pkg. Uncle Ben's Combination White and Wild rice (cooked)

1 can cream of celery soup

1 med. Jar sliced pimento


2 cups French style green beans (drained)
